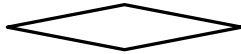

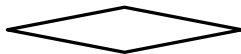

Church Opening Times

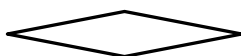
Windsor Parish Church and

mouth and nose



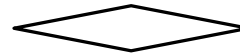
Video in Church

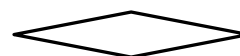


Future Sunday Services in the Team

congregation.



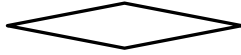

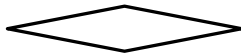


Service Booklets

It is really good to see so many at our 10:00am services.

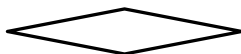

During this time of Corona virus and national lockdown, attendance in our churches is significantly reduced.

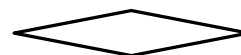

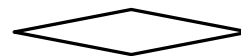
