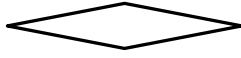

There will be a service of Holy Communion at 11am at Holy Trinity Church

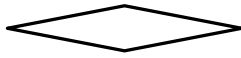


Thy Kingdom Come.

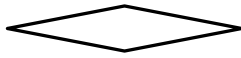

Video in Church

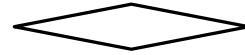
Please be aware that our services are live streamed to Zoom and uploaded to our Youtube & Facebook pages.

Please join from home on zoom if you are in a vulnerable category or have any concerns about attending in person. Please take account of your own safety and that of other members of the congregation.

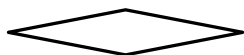

We wish John and Elena all the very best for their wedding at Holy Trinity Church on 24th April. May God richly bless you both.

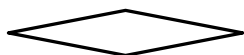


Service Booklets

You will need your bank details and the relevant code for your churches.

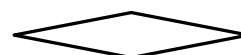
