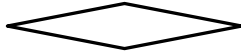

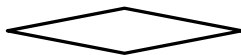

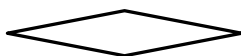
Assisting Hong Kong Migrants

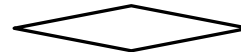
Church Opening Times

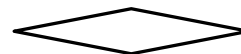
Zoom Services from Church

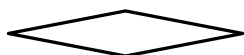

A QR code is now available at the back of the church for you to download the order of service from one of our web sites.

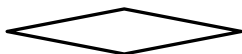


Prayer for the World

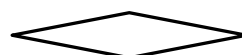
