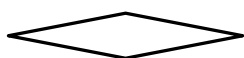

Assisting Hong Kong Migrants

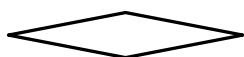

Electoral Roll

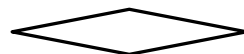
The annual updating of the Electoral Roll is taking place in Holy Trinity and New Windsor parishes. If you wish to join, please speak to a churchwarden and request a form.

Falkland Islands conflict

On 8 June 1982 in Port Pleasant, off Fitzroy, on the Falkland Islands the *Sir Galahad* was attacked and set alight. 48 soldiers and crewmen of the Welsh Guard were killed. Holy Trinity Church will be open from 6-7pm on Tuesday 8th June for those who wish to remember this tragic loss of life. The Welsh Guards are currently stationed in Combermere Barracks.

We will be working to determine the future path of live-streamed services in our team, taking into account the recent survey and other considerations.



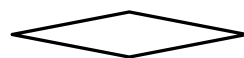
Annual Parochial Church Meetings

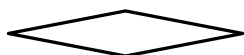

A QR code is now available at the back of the church for you to download the order of service from one of our web sites.

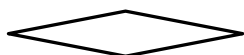


Future Sunday Services in the Team

You will need your bank details and the relevant code for your churches.

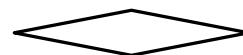
